

# Bespoke Poster Cases

## **Cradley Heath Interchange**

### On walls, windows and up above

The new interchange consists of six bus stands, four within the new main building and two on a newly constructed island stand. This meant that a selection of internal and external information display solutions were required. Having performed the initial site survey and working with Centro and their main contractor, Dawnus, the Horizon Group manufactured and installed:

- Wall & glass mounted informational poster cases
- Secure glass mounted directional and destination tactile cases
- · A selection of generic safety and informational signage
- Overhead directional signage

#### **Versatile Solutions**

With the new Interchange requiring the majority of the poster cases and tactile cases to be glass mounted. The Horizon Group were called upon to use their extensive experience for delivering long lasting solutions to ensure the cases fitted the aesthetics of the new building as well as being safe, secure and long lasting. Also, with the interchange sitting on a gentle downwards slope, fitting the overhead signage required a fixing method that could be adjusted onsite once the specific fitting locations were agreed to ensure uniformity of height.

Using a lightweight but durable material for the signage and an adjustable fixing kit, the Horizon Group was able to deliver consistency across all overhead signage whilst having the flexibility required due to varying floor to ceiling heights and available fixing locations.



### **Perfect Compatibility**

Having used our market leading AP Poster Case Range as the basis for all wall and glass mounted signage, Centro has chosen a long lasting, cost effective case that is built to last the rigours of everyday use. The overhead signage is crisp, clean, easy to follow and fits perfectly with the modern stylings of the new station.

#### A Little Extra Help

During the initial construction phase of the Interchange it became apparent that the new structure would be impeded by an existing steel bracket holding an RTI unit. With build work quickly progressing it was imperative that a new smaller bracket was produced to ensure work was not delayed. It was also vital that the RTI unit was kept operational for the day to day delivery of train times for a high volume of passengers.



#### The solution

Centro turned to the Horizon Group to quickly turnaround a new bracket that would be easily fixed to the existing post, could house all existing wiring and that would allow for the quick installation of the RTI unit. Within 5 days of initial brief the Horizon Group had built, painted and delivered a new bracket which was installed on site without any issues. This short project was another example of the adaptability that the Horizon Group shows to help clients in tricky, time sensitive situations.
